NOTE:-

1. All colleges, University Centres, Department Students Union/Institute of Tribal Studies and Research (ITSR), Chethalayam, Wayanad/DSU-TSR (JMC Along with Department of Forensic Sciences in the Police Academy Campus) should strictly follow this schedule and no changes in the election schedule will be permitted.
2. All the affiliated colleges, University Centres, Department Students Union/Institute of Tribal Studies and Research (ITSR), Chethalayam, Wayanad/DSU-TSR (JMC Along with Department of Forensic Sciences in the Police Academy Campus) are directed to include all the students admitted on or before 19.09.2025 in the Final Electoral Roll.
3. All the affiliated colleges, University Centres, Department Students Union/Institute of Tribal Studies and Research (ITSR), Chethalayam, Wayanad/DSU-TSR (JMC Along with Department of Forensic Sciences in the Police Academy Campus) are directed to conduct the College Union Election in any of the three modes suggested by the Lyndgoh Committee and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
4. All the affiliated colleges, University Centres, Department Students Union/Institute of Tribal Studies and Research (ITSR), Chethalayam, Wayanad/DSU-TSR (JMC Along with Department of Forensic

Sciences in the Police Academy Campus) are directed to include the column "NOTA" (None Of The Above) option in the Electoral Voting Machines and Ballot papers, as directed by the UGC.

5. The Principals of all Colleges and University Centres/ President of Department Students Union/ Director of Institute of Tribal Studies and Research (ITSR), Chethalayam, Wayanad/Director of DSU-TSR (JMC Along with Department of Forensic Sciences in the Police Academy Campus) should appoint Returning Officers and report their names and contact details to the University.
6. If any of the above mentioned in para 5 could not conduct the election as per this schedule, due to any unforeseen circumstances, it shall report the matter to the Vice Chancellor immediately. If they wish to conduct the election on another date, the new schedule should be sent to the Vice Chancellor for approval. No election can be conducted without the permission of the Vice Chancellor.
7. Institute of Tribal Studies and Research (ITSR), Chethalayam, Wayanad will have a separate Union.
8. The departments at JMC along with the Department of Forensic Sciences in the Police Academy Campus, Thrissur be treated as a separate Union with name DSU-TSR
9. Full Time Research scholars of each campus, including colleges, shall have voting rights as part of the respective College Union.
