## COLLEGE RULES

1. The class time is from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm. Students must attend all their classes as per the timetable and instructions given to them.
2. ID Card is compulsory. Students are not allowed to enter the campus without wearing the ID Card officially as it is instructed by the college. It should be worn round the neck as it can be seen.
3. During the time of College Prayer and National Anthem all students should stand in perfect silence and devotion.
4. Students should not engage themselves in any actions that are offensive to the smooth running of the institution and harmful to the Student Community.
- 5 Student should put on their uniforms and Identity card once they are in the Campus.
6. Use and possession of tobacco, panparag, Liquor and such other intoxicating items are strictly prohibited inside the campus.
7. Any kind of act, verbal or non-verbal, against a new entrant of the College will be treated as ragging and the accused, if any, will be made liable for punishment as per the Indian Penal Code. Ragging of any form is a non-bailable offense and requires criminal procedure. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, severe action will be taken against such students and the case will be forwarded to the police for further action under criminal procedure. They will be forbidden from pursuing their studies here or in any other institutions for five years.

8. No one should distribute or circulate any notice, pamphlet, leaflet etc, at the gate or inside the Campus without the pre-consent of the principal. Display of any type of banner, flag, poster etc. is also strictly forbidden.
9. Without the pre-consent of the principal, all are strictly prohibited from participating in any agitation, strike, dharna and in any such activities which will disturb the classes and are pernicious to the peaceful atmosphere of the campus.
10. Outsiders are not permitted to attend or organize any programme or activity without the prior permission of the Principal. No student should invite or entertain such outsiders. Entry for media persons is allowed only with the prior permission from the principal.
11. The Principal will have the power to inflict the punishments like suspension, compulsory issue of TC and expulsion.
12. Conduct Certificate will not be issued as a matter of Course. It has to be earned by the students good conduct, the behaviour in and out the campus. The principal's decision will be final regarding the issue of Conduct Certificate.
13. Promotion to higher Class, selection for semester end examinations and issue of progress, attendance or Conduct Certificate are matters absolutely within the discretion of the principal in respect of the University norms.

- 14 The Principal will have the right to issue Transfer Certificate to a student without an application from the student or the guardian at any time during the course of his/her study in the College on any violation of college rules.
15. The principal or duly constituted College or hostel authorities will have the right to frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules regulating the conduct of students within and outside the College and the hostel premises with a view to maintaining the credit and reputation of the College and the hostels.
16. Students should desist from disfiguring the class rooms, Compound walls and buildings in the college campus by sticking posters, play cards, banners etc or writing on them They should also desist from disfiguring the belongings of the institution.
17. As per the Judgement of the Honorable High- Court of Kerala, the principal has the right to control the organizational activities of Student Organizations in the campus.
18. Students who are charged of criminal offenses and are under suspension will not be allowed to enter the campus without permission.
19. No meeting, procession or celebration shall be organized or no fund be collected in the College or the hostels without the permission from the Principal. Processions for any cause is strictly prohibited during class hours.
- 20 Students should not go outside the college during class hours. In the case of unavoidable necessity, they should seek special permission from the head of the department.

21. During the class hours, Students are not allowed loiter in the campus and on the premises of the college.
22. Students should be neat, tidy and modest in dressing and personal appearance.
23. The Certificate of Attendance to appear for the semester end examination will not be issued unless the Principal is convinced that the students' conduct and progress have been satisfactory and the student has secured 75% of attendance in the Semester. Students may also note that unless they register for the semester end examination, they will not be eligible for the next semester.
24. The Principal reserves the right to take punitory measures which include suspension/ dismissal from the College/Hostel, Compulsory issue of TC, imposing permission to apply for fine, refusal of for examination and forwarding of the complained to the police.
25. The Principal shall be the final authority in the interpretation of the college rules. matters not covered by these rules are left to the discretion of the Principal and his decisions shall be final.
26. Those who have been caught and arrested by the police or accused by any Govt. authority with solid proof for using drugs of any kind or those who are indulged in any other anti-social activities will be terminated from the college without any warning.
27. The authority will have the rights to terminate the student if he/she is proved using drugs or any kind of intoxicating items out side the campus also.

## Library Rules

### General Conduct

**HOSTEL RULES.**

1. Admission is only for one year. The Provost reserves the right to grant or deny admission/readmission.
2. Parent or guardian should be present at the time of admission/readmission.
3. Residents are bound to comply with all the rules of the hostel as set down by the Chief Warden.
4. Residents should strictly observe the study time (06:00 AM - 08:00 AM and 08:00 PM - 10:30 PM).
5. Residents are not permitted to receive or entertain guests, including their class/college mates, without prior written permission from the Warden/Matron.
6. Residents should return to the hostel by 5:00 PM after their classes.
7. Residents should not go outside the hostel without the permission of the Warden.
8. Residents should abstain from the use or possession of alcoholic drinks, drugs, and tobacco products.
9. The attendance position of the residents will be periodically checked, and those who are found to be irregular in class will not be permitted to continue in the hostel.

10. It is the responsibility of the residents to ensure that the rooms allotted to them are kept tidy. Electrical fittings, furniture, and other facilities provided in the rooms should remain intact.
11. Residents will be heavily fined for the loss of or damage to hostel property. They are not permitted to make any alterations in the room.
12. The attitude and relationship of the residents with the hostel staff should be cordial and respectful.
13. Residents must make entries in the movement register kept at the hostel while leaving and returning. Parents/guardians should accompany the students when necessary.
14. Residents who wish to stay in the hostel during vacations should get prior permission from the Chief Warden/Provost.
15. Hostel dues for each month should be cleared before the 15th of the following month. Defaulters will be removed from the hostel roll.
16. Readmission will strictly be based on academic performance, attendance percentage in the previous semester, and the resident's character and behavior in both the hostel and the college.
17. Ragging is a criminal offence (Govt. Order No. 1157/12/86 H.Edn), and the names of the accused will be forwarded to the police. They will be immediately dismissed from the hostel.
18. Grievances, complaints, or suggestions from the residents can be brought to the notice of the Matron.
19. The decision of the Provost pertaining to all hostel matters will be final.

## **Issue of Certificate**

1. Application for any Certificate should be submitted at least two days in advance
2. Conduct Certificate will Ordinarily be issued. Along with the transfer certificate when the Student has Completed the programme.
3. Certificate of any kind will be issued from the College only if the Principal is convinced of the reason stated by the applicant for the Same.


