NOTE:-

1. This election schedule shall apply to all affiliated colleges and University Centres, except the Centres in the University Campuses (CU Campus and JMC-TSR).
2. This election schedule shall apply to all affiliated colleges and University Centres outside the University Campuses, and all such institutions shall strictly adhere to the notified schedule. No change in the election schedule shall be permitted.
3. All affiliated colleges and University Centres outside the University Campuses shall include in the Final Electoral Roll all students admitted on or before 28.09.2026, subject to their eligibility under the applicable rules.
4. All affiliated colleges and University Centres shall conduct the College Union Election in any of the modes recommended by the Lyngdoh Committee and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
5. All affiliated colleges and University Centres outside the University Campuses shall include the option "NOTA (None of the Above)" in the ballot papers, as directed by the UGC.
6. If any college or University Centre is unable to conduct the election in accordance with the notified schedule due to any unforeseen circumstances, the matter shall be reported to the Vice-Chancellor immediately. If the institution proposes to conduct the election on an alternative date, the revised election schedule shall be submitted to the Vice-Chancellor for approval. No election shall be conducted on an alternative date without the prior approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
7. The following age limits shall apply to candidates contesting the College Union Election:
 - o UG students: 17–22 years; for the upper age limit, the date of birth shall be on or after 30.09.2003.
 - o PG students/IPG (4th and 5th year): 24–25 years; for the upper age limit, the date of birth shall be on or after 30.09.2001.
